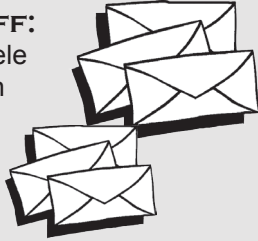

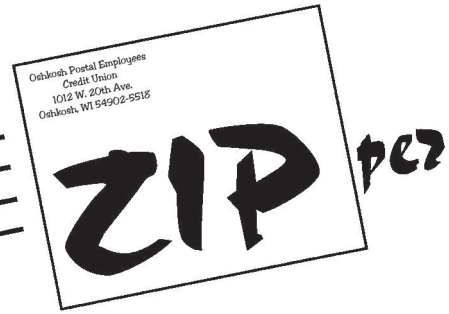

This motto is the basis of a powerful force -- the credit union movement. It sums up the beliefs that guide these non-profit financial cooperatives.

It is the phrase that guided the establishment of your Oshkosh Postal Employees Credit Union more than 91 years ago.

And it is a different philosophy than the one that guides banks.

■ Banks generate their profits for their owners, which often are multinational holding companies.

■ Credit unions manage their finances with the best interests of their member-owners in mind.

By pooling member-owner resources, credit unions are able to manage their finances at the best possible terms -- allowing member-owners to save and borrow at good rates and terms.

This cooperative idea began in Germany in the mid-1800s when community members found it difficult to get loans. The idea caught on and eventually came to the United States in the early 1900s.

In the U.S., the idea has thrived, with public confidence strengthened by the National Credit Union Share Fund. With it, deposits are federally insured -- much like the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation insures bank deposits.

“People helping people” has kept OPECU going for more than 90 years.

OPECU can not do it without each one of you. It is YOUR credit union and only YOU make it possible for OPECU to exist and thrive.

When you get work done on your home, it is best to write the check out to the person instead of the business.

A check to a business will not be able to be cashed at OPECU unless the business has an account here. However, the tradesperson can cash your check with us by using his or her driver's license.

If you find your debit card is compromised on a weekend, call 1-800-523-4175. That call can cancel your card right away. You don't have to wait until we open Monday morning, and find that more of your money is gone. However, if OPECU is open, call us first, so we can cancel the card and get you a new one sooner. The sooner the card is can-

celed, the faster your money remains with you.
