NO stop payment option on MAC Card debit card

Debit card transactions are processed very quickly. Unfortunately that means there is **NO** stop payment option on the MAC prepaid debit card.

You can stop payment on your checks and on ACH -- Automated Clearing House -- electronic bank-to-bank payments.

If you buy an item, set up to buy an item, or don't receive an item when using your debit card, it is up to **YOU** to contact that merchant and work it out. OPECU

does not have the "stop pay option" on our MAC Card.

If you are concerned that the company you are buying from might not deliver what is promised, consider using a credit card instead of a debit card. The Fair Credit Billing Act, which applies to credit cards but not debit cards, gives you the ability -- under certain circumstances -- to withhold payment on defective goods until the problem has been corrected.

Free shredding-recycling event June 4

Oshkosh Postal Employees Credit Union is partnering with several other local credit unions to bring the first-ever free secure shred and electronics recycling event to the Oshkosh community for all of our member-owners.

The event runs 8 to 11 a.m. June 4 in the Oshkosh Corp. parking lot, 1917 Four Wheel Drive, Oshkosh.

You can bring up to five grocery bags of sensitive documents for secure document shredding.

Most small household and electronics are free to recycle with a fee charged for larger items or those that contain hazardous materials.

Full-size refrigerators or freezers and items not listed here are not accepted.

Free items include audio equipment, cords and cables, CPU towers, desktop printers, laptops, keyboards, mice, modems, networking equipment, phones, projectors, power tools, routers, satellite boxes and video gaming systems.

Fees of from \$15 to \$60 are charged for flat and CRT computer monitors and TVs; wood console or projection TVs, large copy machines, microwaves, dehumidifiers, window air conditioning units, ovens or dishwashers, clothes washers and dryers, and dorm-size refrigerators.

Participants are asked to stay in their cars when delivering items. Please stay home if you are sick or if you have been exposed to someone who is sick.

When using the drive-through, count any cash BEFORE you leave. If there is a mistake, it can be taken care of then. Otherwise, you must wait until the end of the day when we balance drawers.

If you give a check from your OPECU account to a person or place that

uses remote capture (sending a photo of the check through their phone to their financial account), the account numbers are usually missing. That makes the check kick out on our system. We have to hand post and charge a \$5 fee.

Make sure all numbers at the bottom of the check go through or it will cost you OR ask them to NOT use remote capture.



Ordered checks are taking longer to deliver since the Post Office changed its standards of delivery.

The reorder form is found on the second to the last book of checks in the packet. Don't wait until the last book or you may not get those reordered checks when you need them.
