

It's a new year and the scams are back

It may be a new year but scam artists still haven't changed their ways. They are still trying clever methods to steal money from you.

There are ways you can protect yourself. Here is the basic and number one thing to remember: If it sounds too good to be true, it is!

If you don't know the company in question or you did not make the call – it's a scam!

Scam artists today have so many ways to get to you with their lies -- by phone, by text, by mail, and even by advertising online.

Have you heard of this scam? It should send up a big red flag in your mind. Someone offers to send you a check and asks you to send them gift cards in return. And the "deal" is that YOU get to keep some of the money for your efforts.

But guess what happens? That check

Attention parents and grandparents! Enroll your young ones in our birthday club. The \$5 fee starts their credit union savings account. Put them on your payroll deduction and watch their funds grow.

A message from your CU president

will bounce. You will be out the amount of the check. By that time, the scam artist will already have the gift card(s). You lose.

Here's another way to protect yourself: Watch your statements or online accounts! If you see something that looks weird or is not yours, report it to us immediately.

Even though most of these scams are aimed at the elderly, anyone can fall prey to these predators. We are aware of one young person, for example, who was tricked through a Craigslist ad and ended up nearly \$6,000 in the hole.

Please be vigilant and safe as you work toward a secure financial future in 2023.

Save yourself time, trouble - know these Visa/MacCard rules

below and save yourself time and trou- 90 days from when you notify us. ble if or when things go wrong.

- MasterCard at least once in a six-month period throughout the term (expiration date) of the card. If you don't you may not be issued another card. NOTE: Our cards are issued during the month they expire.
- ► Check your statements monthly or whenever you receive them for any unauthorized deposits or withdrawals.

Why? Because, as noted on the statements (OPECU's, Visa's, MacCard's),

MacCards are made for convenience. you receive that statement to notify us But to make things run smoothly, there of any errors or unauthorized items. are rules to follow. Review these points That means that we can only look back

If you tell us about something that ▶ You MUST use your Visa or happened further back in time, it would be too late for us to do anything about it. The sooner we get the information from you, the sooner we can stop any errors or unauthorized transactions.

> ► If you do want to notify us, a phone call alone may not do. We need the information in writing to make sure we get the correct errors. You can call but plan to come in sooner rather than later as we can only cancel the card – not work towards the chargeback until it is in writing. If the problem is with Visa,

OPECU-issued Visa charge cards and you only have 60 days from the time notify them as they have all the infor-

► When you report lost/stolen card information to MacCard or Visa, their spokespersons always say they will order you a new card. BUT THEY CAN'T! You have to call us. We order the cards

However, if your cards are stolen over the weekend or when we are closed, you will need to call each card company to stop transactions immedicately.

For MacCard, call the 1-800 number we gave you (or listed on the website) to stop the card immediately. For Visa, call their number on your statement. If it happens on the weekend and you wait, your account could be down to \$0.00!
