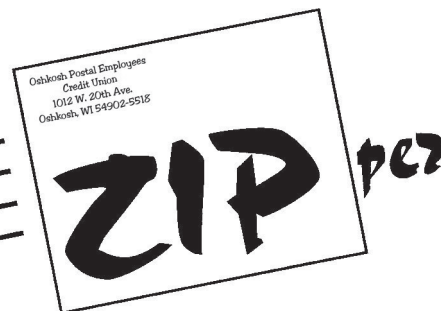
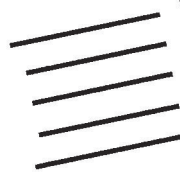

Avoid financial hassles with these tips

Here are a few "Okay, I get it" reminders to reduce or eliminate those little financial irritations that can happen

✓ When using the drive-through, count any cash *BEFORE* you leave. That way, if there is a mistake, it can be taken care of immediately. If not, you must wait until day's end when we balance our drawers.

✓ Let's say you give a check from your OPECU account to a person or place that uses "remote capture." That is a process where your check is photographed or scanned to be cleared electronically into

another account. We have found that sometimes the account numbers are missing. If they are, our system kicks out the check. We then have to hand post it and charge you a \$5 fee. Make sure all numbers on the bottom of the check go through or it will cost you. Or you could ask them to **not** use remote capture.

✓ Any time there is a change in your life, let us know. If we can't reach you because of address, phone, or email changes, it may result in financial problems for you that could have been easily avoided.

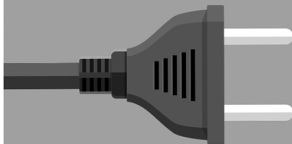
